



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of establishing the Amissopian foreign policy apparatus.

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, pursuant to I.6 of the Charter of the Amissopian Federation, known as the Minister of Foreign Affairs, who shall be responsible for representing the Federation internationally on behalf of the President of the Federation.
2. The Minister of Foreign Affairs shall chair an executive agency, the Department of State, and may appoint and dismiss such staff to and from said agency at their discretion for the purpose of delegating their tasks.
3. The Minister of Foreign Affairs shall appoint, with the approval of the President, individuals to serve as ambassadors to foreign powers, and those individuals shall be considered employees of the Department of State and shall interact with the foreign power to which they are posted on behalf of the government.
4. The Minister of Foreign Affairs may, by statutory instrument:
 - a. Issue documents announcing what criteria the Amissopian government will use to determine whether to take on foreign relations with another power;
 - b. Appoint ambassadors and consuls to other foreign powers pursuant to I.3 of this Act;
 - c. Confer Belligerent status on other micronational powers, marking them for observation by the Department of State and recommending them to the President for further sanction.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the State Department Law.
