



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of organising the various government forms

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, the Amissopian Webmaster, who shall answer directly to the Executive Office of the President.
2. The Amissopian Webmaster shall be responsible for maintaining the government website, hosted at amissopia.co.uk (hereafter referred to as the "government website").

ARTICLE II

1. The Amissopian Webmaster shall create a section of the government website which shall be dedicated to compiling all forms developed by executive officers and agencies of the federal government.
2. Forms shall be titled "XX-Y: 'Title'", where:
 - a. "XX" shall be substituted for a two letter abbreviation for the executive officer or agency which is creating the form. This list of abbreviations shall include:
 - i. "PR" for the Executive Office of the President;
 - ii. "EM" for the office of the Emperor;
 - iii. "DS" for the Department of State;
 - iv. "DI" for the Department of the Interior;
 - v. "DN" for the Department of Intelligence;
 - vi. "DT" for the Department of Transportation;
 - vii. "DC" for the Department of Culture;
 - viii. "DL" for the Department of Local Government;
 - ix. "DU" for the Department of Triumviran Affairs;
 - x. "MS" for the Office of the MSB Envoy;
 - xi. "FT" for the Foreign Travel Advisory Service;
 - xii. "LC" for the Levaria Compliance Division;
 - xiii. "FP" for the Federal Police;
 - xiv. "CR" for the Civil Rights Division;
 - xv. "LV" for the Lake Venom Presidential Commission;
 - xvi. "FE" for the Federal Elections and Referendums Commission;
 - xvii. "NE" for the National Emergency Management Agency;
 - xviii. "OB" for the Office of Bureaucratic Diagramming;
 - xix. "ON" for the Office of National Statistics;
 - xx. "AE" for the Amissopian Enquirer;
 - xxi. "AC" for the Amissopian Conlang Institute;
 - xxii. "WH" for the Whestcorean Heritage Institute;
 - xxiii. "UH" for the Universal Triumvirate Heritage Institute;
 - xxiv. "IC" for the Intermicronational Constitutional Repository;
 - xxv. "IT" for the Intermicronational Treaty Repository;
 - xxvi. "IB" for the Intermicronational Banknote Repository;
 - xxvii. "IP" for the Intermicronational Collapsed Projects Repository.



- b. "Y" shall be substituted for a number, which shall start at 1 and iterate upwards for every form that is created by the executive agency creating it. For instance, the first Department of State form will carry the number 1, the second form 2 and so on in that fashion.
3. Forms submitted by federal agencies that do not comply with this format may have their titles altered by the Amissopian Webmaster unilaterally.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Forms Law.
