



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of creating the office of Amissopian Emperor

ARTICLE I

- a. The President shall be daily required to issue a Presidential Directive, expiring upon the conclusion of the day, designating any individual, foreign or domestic, as Amissopian Emperor.
 - a. In the event that the President fails to appoint a new Emperor under the provisions of this Law, the position will be held to be in an interregnum period with no incumbent until a new Emperor is appointed.
 - b. In the event that the President appoints an Emperor part-way through the day they would have served, their term of office shall still expire upon the natural end of that day.
- b. The Amissopian Emperor shall have no additional governmental powers conferred on them, but may, for the period of their term in office, carry the moniker of "His Imperial Highness, the Amissopian Emperor".

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Imperial Law.
