



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of establishing a Department of the Interior and a national statistics gathering organisation

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, pursuant to I.6 of the Charter of the Federation, known as the Minister for Home Affairs, who shall be responsible for developing domestic policy for the management of federal Amissopian lands and national security.
2. The Minister for Home Affairs shall chair an executive agency, the Department of the Interior, which shall be responsible for assisting the Minister for Home Affairs in the execution of their duties and which they may staff at their discretion for the purpose of delegating their tasks.
3. The Minister for Home Affairs shall chair an executive agency, the Office for National Statistics, which shall be responsible for gathering whatever statistics it deems prudent for publication regarding the Amissopian Federation. The Office shall be subordinate to the Department of the Interior.
4. The Minister for Home Affairs shall chair an executive agency, the Office for Naturalisation, which shall be responsible for processing citizenship and nationalisation requests.
5. The Minister for Home Affairs may, by statutory instrument:
 - a. Declare any area of the Amissopian Federation, regardless of state, to be a federal national park, placing it under direct federal jurisdiction and entitling it to federal environmental protections;
 - b. Set out any regulations surrounding the use and access of federal national parks, including environmental protections per I.5.a of this Law;
 - c. Set out citizenship application requirements for prospective Amissopian citizens per I.4 of this Law;
 - d. Raise or lower the National Defense Readiness Condition System level at their discretion.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Interior Department Law.
