## A LAW

For the purpose of providing for a lack of Imperial appointment.

### ARTICLE I

1. The Imperial Law is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. The Law shall have a new I.1.a, which shall read as follows: "In the event that the President fails to appoint a new Emperor under the provisions of this Law, the position will be held to be in an interregnum period with no incumbent until a new Emperor is appointed."
  - b. The Law shall have a new I.1.b, which shall read as follows: "In the event that the President appoints an Emperor part-way through the day they would have served, their term of office shall still expire upon the natural end of that day."

### ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Interregnum Law.
