



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of organising the various government forms

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, the Law Commissioner, who shall answer directly to the President.
2. The Law Commissioner shall chair an executive agency, the Law Commission, which will be a subordinate agency to the Executive Office of the President.
3. The Law Commissioner shall, at the end of every calendar month starting August 2018:
 - a. Release a Law Commission Review, detailing whether the federal laws currently on the statute books require updating;
 - b. In the event that certain laws require updating, what updates are required;
 - c. Make such recommendations in pursuance of their brief as they shall deem prudent.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Law Commission Law.
