## A LAW

For the purpose of setting the territorial extent of the Amissopian Federation, the provinces thereof, and the system of city creation therein

### ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, pursuant to I.6 of the Charter of the Amissopian Federation, known as the Minister of Local Government, who shall be responsible for liaising on behalf of the President's government with delegated bodies of government as created by law.
2. The Minister of Local Government shall chair an executive agency, the Department of Local Government, and may appoint and dismiss such staff to and from the agency at their discretion for the purpose of delegating their tasks.
3. The Minister of Local Government may, by statutory instrument:
  - a. Create cities in any area of the Amissopian Federation, provided they:
    - i. Draft and present for presidential approval a charter for the city's government, detailing who or what will be responsible for the governance of the city and what ordinances it shall have power to create;
    - ii. Select a location for it within Amissopian territory that is not already occupied by another city.
  - b. Temporarily appoint and dismiss individuals to city governments, provided the system of government established within the city charter is subsequently restored within a reasonable time frame.
4. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, pursuant to I.6 of the Charter of the Amissopian Federation, known as the Minister of Transportation, who shall be responsible for creating roads and motorways between the various cities and states of the nation.
5. The Minister of Transportation shall chair an executive agency, the Department of Transportation, and may appoint and dismiss such staff to and from the agency at their discretion for the purpose of delegating their tasks.
6. The Minister of Transportation may, by statutory instrument:
  - a. Make such amendments to the road networks of the nation that they shall deem prudent;
  - b. Build transport hubs at various locations, irrespective of which state it is housed in.

### ARTICLE II

1. Amissopia will occupy the area demarcated by government officials.
2. The northern border of Amissopia will be separated from the United Kingdom by a cardboard wall (hereafter referred to as the "Great Wall").
3. Amissopia will be split into eight states:
  - a. New New Jersey, at the northwestern border, bordering the United Kingdom to the west, the Great Wall to the north, East New New Jersey to the east, New Edenopolis to the south and Madison State to the southeast;
  - b. East New New Jersey, which shall border the state of Brandenburg to the east, Madison State to the south, New New Jersey to the west and the Great Wall to the north;
  - c. Brandenburg, which shall border East New New Jersey to the west, the Great Wall to the north, Zenith to the south and East Amissopia to the east;



- d. East Amissopia, which shall border the United Kingdom to the east and south, Brandenburg to the northwest, Zenith to the southwest, the Great Wall to the north and shall border on its north, east and south side the District of Madison;
  - e. Zenith, which shall border the District of Madison and East Amissopia to the east, Brandenburg to the north, Madison State to the northwest, the Badlands to the southwest, and the United Kingdom to the south;
  - f. Madison State, which shall border Zenith to the east, the Badlands to the south, East New New Jersey to the north, New Edenopolis to the west and New New Jersey to the northwest;
  - g. The Badlands, which shall border Zenith to the northeast, Madison State to the north, New Edenopolis to the northwest and the United Kingdom to the west, east, and south;
  - h. New Edenopolis, which shall border the Badlands to the south, the United Kingdom to the west, New New Jersey to the north and Zenith to the northeast.
4. There shall additionally be a federal district, which shall serve as the nation's capital, nestled between the state of East Amissopia to the north, east and south and the state of Zenith to the west.
  5. All states and the federal district shall be entitled to establish amongst themselves systems of government, though this shall not preclude the President from establishing such systems of government in these locations as they shall deem prudent at their own discretion if it is felt necessary.
  6. The President shall, as time and resources permit, create the various flags for these states, and they shall become the flags for the various states upon presidential proclamation.
  7. A map of the nation shall be created, and the various amendments to the geography and infrastructure of the nation shall be illustrated on said map by the President at their discretion.
  8. No state may impede the movement of national citizens between the various states of the nation.

### **ARTICLE III**

1. "Delegated bodies of government" shall refer to any body capable of governing within the Amissopian Federation that is not the national government created by the Charter of the Federation.
2. "Ordinances" shall, in context of this act, be taken to refer to any law passed that is enacted by the legitimate government of a city and which has effect only within the city limits.
3. "Transport hubs" shall be taken to refer to airports, bus stations, train stations, and other buildings and locations with the express purpose of conveying people from one location to another.
4. The "area demarcated by government officials" is the cardboard sheet demarcated with state boundaries on the windowsill of the presidential residence.
5. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
6. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
7. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Territorial Establishment Law.
