

## OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

## A LAW

For the purpose of streamline the treaty-making process

## ARTICLE I

- a. Any treaty that shall attain the signature of the President shall be considered a Law for the purposes of domestic and international enforcement.
- b. A treaty for the purpose of this Law shall be defined as any agreement between the Amissopian Federation and a foreign power, either another micronation, macronation or international organisation.
- c. The President may delegate their treaty-signing power to any official of the federal government.

## **ARTICLE II**

- 1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
- 2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
- 3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Treaties Law.
