



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of establishing a Ministry of Culture and a Whestcorean Heritage Institute

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be a subordinate executive officer, pursuant to I.6 of the Charter of the Federation, known as the Minister of Culture, who shall be responsible for formulating government policy on cultural and historical matters of importance.
2. The Minister of Culture shall chair an executive agency, the Department of Culture, and may appoint and dismiss staff to and from said agency at their discretion for the purpose of delegating their tasks.
3. The Minister of Culture shall additionally chair an agency subordinate to the Department of Culture, the Whestcorean Heritage Institute, the responsibility of which shall be to maintain, centralise and archive all documents and other artefacts relating to the former Federal Republic of Whestcorea.
4. The Minister of Culture may, by statutory instrument:
 - a. Declare areas of the Federation to be National Heritage Sites, entitling them to federal protection;
 - b. Subordinate the task of running the Whestcorean Heritage Institute to a Director they may appoint.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Whestcorean Heritage Law.
