



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of establishing a Department of Intelligence World Encyclopaedia.

ARTICLE I

1. The Department of Intelligence shall publish, when it deems prudent and at its discretion, entries in the Department of Intelligence World Encyclopaedia, which shall contain detailed articles about other micronations, containing:
 - a. An introduction, giving a broad summary of the nation and its history;
 - b. Its geographical location and topographical information, as well as land area, maritime claims (if any), and other geographical factors, if information is available;
 - c. Population numbers, the languages spoken, the ethnic groups living in the nation, the average age of the general population and other such information, if data is available;
 - d. Government information, including the legal name of the state, its form of government, the current heads of state and government, the Constitution if one exists, political parties therein if they exist, and organisational affiliations if any, if data is available, as well as any diplomatic representation in the Amissopian Federation;
 - e. Details on the flag and national anthem;
 - f. Details on the economy, if one exists and data is available;
 - g. Military capability, if data is available;
 - h. Transnational issues, including disputes with other nations, if data is available.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the World Encyclopaedia Law.
