



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For establishing a Bureau of Land Management as an agency of the Department of the Interior

ARTICLE I

- a. There shall be an executive agency subordinate to the Department of the Interior known as the Bureau of Land Management.
- b. The Bureau of Land Management (hereafter BoLM) shall be chaired by a Chief Executive, who shall be responsible for the operation and organisation of the BoLM.
- c. For the purpose of the Bureau of Land Management's responsibilities, all land is federal land except where:
 - a. The land is owned by a private citizen or organisation, for instance in the case of a building under the Architectural Regulation Law;
 - b. Laws stipulate that the Bureau of Land Management's authority does not extend to the land in question.
- d. The Bureau may recolour, destroy, or otherwise change any federal land at its own discretion and the direction of the Chief Executive, the Minister of the Interior, or the President.

ARTICLE II

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Land Management Law.
