



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of amending Amissopian law to allow for the enactment of the New Florentine treaty

ARTICLE I

1. There shall be an executive agency, subordinate to the Department of State, known as the Florentine Liaison Agency (hereafter “the FLA”), which shall be chaired by the Chief Liaison Officer (hereafter “the director”).
2. The director:
 - a. Shall be appointed by the President;
 - b. Shall serve at the pleasure of the President and of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, both of whom may enact his dismissal, though a dismissal order made by the Minister of Foreign Affairs may be countermanded by a presidential direction);
 - c. May arrange, appoint and dismiss the staff of their agency at their discretion.
3. The FLA shall be responsible for appointing the staff of the President and the President’s delegation to the Council on Florentine-Amissopian Affairs (hereafter “the council”) pursuant to Article II, Section 5 of the Treaty on Comprehensive Partnership between the Government of the Amissopian Federation and the Government of New Florence (hereafter “the treaty”).
4. The FLA may additionally make appointments specifically to the President’s staff within one of the council’s sub-councils, enumerated in Article II, Section 6 of the treaty.

ARTICLE II

1. For the purposes of Article III, Section 9 of the treaty, the Minister of Justice shall be the nominated law enforcement officer of the Amissopian federal government.
2. There shall be a subordinate agency of the Department of Justice, the Extradition Office, which shall be chaired by a Director-General.
3. The Director-General of the Extradition Office:
 - a. Shall be appointed by the President;
 - b. Shall serve at the pleasure of the President and of the Minister of Justice, and may be dismissed by either (though a ministerial dismissal may be countermanded by a presidential direction);
 - c. May arrange, appoint, and dismiss the staff of their agency at their discretion.
4. The Extradition Office shall be responsible for arranging with their counterparts in other nations the extradition of suspects within Amissopian jurisdiction.
5. The Extradition Office may not extradite a suspect when requested by another nation if:
 - a. There is no guarantee that the suspect will receive a fair trial when they are returned to their country;
 - b. The Extradition Office has reasonable belief that the suspect will be subject to the death penalty upon their conviction;
 - c. The crime the suspect is accused of is not a crime under either Amissopian law or the criminal code established in Article 3, Section 4 of the treaty.
6. The terms of Article 3, Section 3 of the treaty shall be held as superior law to Article II, Section 5 of this law in the event that the two sets of provisions come into conflict.



ARTICLE III

1. There shall be an executive department, the Department of Trade, responsible for administering to international trade between the Amissopian Federation and other nations.
2. The Department of Trade shall be chaired by a Minister of International Trade, who shall be appointed by the President and who shall serve at their pleasure.
3. The Minister of International Trade:
 - a. May, by statutory instrument:
 - i. Enact tariffs against certain types of goods, provided such tariffs are in compliance with the terms of the customs union enacted in Article 5 of the treaty;
 - ii. Levy economic or trading sanctions against other nations or organisations;
 - iii. Ban other nations or organisations from trading within or with the Amissopian Federation;
 - iv. Enact regulations on certain goods in terms of:
 1. How they are manufactured;
 2. What they may be composed of;
 3. How many of those goods may be sold or transported at a given time;
 4. How those goods may be transported;
 5. Where those goods may be held;
 6. Who those goods may be sold to.
 - b. May appoint, dismiss and otherwise arrange the staff of subordinate executive agencies at their discretion.
4. There shall be an executive agency, subordinate to the Department of Trade, known as the Customs Union Compliance Bureau (hereafter the "CUCB"), chaired by a Director-General.
5. The Director-General of the CUCB may appoint, dismiss, and otherwise arrange the staff of the CUCB at their discretion.
6. The CUCB shall be responsible for issuing legal opinions to the federal government and other key governmental stakeholders regarding executive or legislative actions, advising said stakeholders or the government as to whether those actions are compliant with the terms of the customs union of which the Federation is a member under the terms of the treaty.
7. Organisations that are banned from trading within or with the Amissopian Federation pursuant to an instrument issued under Article III, Section a, Subsection iii, are precluded from seeking intellectual property protection under the terms of the Federal Patents and Trademarks Act.

ARTICLE IV

1. There shall be a subordinate agency of the Department of State, the Homeland Security Office, which shall be chaired by a Minister of Homeland Security.
2. The Minister of Homeland Security, title notwithstanding, will not automatically be entitled to ministerial status on the cabinet level unless invited by the President.
3. The Minister of Homeland Security:
 - a. Shall be appointed by the President;
 - b. Shall serve at the pleasure of the President and the Minister of State (though a ministerial dismissal may be countermanded by a presidential direction);
 - c. May arrange, appoint and dismiss the staff of their agency at their discretion.
 - d. May, by statutory instrument:



- i. Set regulations for what documentation is required for certain individuals to enter the nation;
 - ii. Set regulations for what security measures are implemented at ports of entry to the Amissopian Federation;
 1. Ports of entry shall be defined as any location where an individual may gain access to the Amissopian Federation from outside of the Federation itself.
4. Individuals who possess citizenship of New Florence shall only be required to display proof of citizenship of New Florence to gain access to the Amissopian Federation and may not be further hindered from entrance.
5. The Homeland Security Office shall be responsible for maintaining the security of the borders of the Amissopian Federation, and may take steps to doing so pursuant to Article IV, Section 3, Subsection d of this law.
6. The federal government hereby declares the Federal Patents and Trademarks Bureau to be its copyright authority to the intellectual property council of the Council under Article 6, Section 7 of the treaty.

ARTICLE V

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the New Florentine Comprehensive Partnership Law.
