



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of requiring that agents in the employ of the interests of foreign powers active within the Amissopian Federation be required to register themselves as such with the Amissopian Department of State

ARTICLE I

- 1) For the purposes of this Law, and where not specified otherwise, any reference to “the Minister” is in reference to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State Department.
- 2) For the purposes of this Law, the “Amissopian Federation” is all territory controlled and administered to by the Amissopian Government.
- 3) For the purposes of this Law, and where not specified otherwise, the term “foreign power” means any government of a foreign power, any individual living abroad, a political party active in a foreign country, or otherwise any foreign business, partnership, association or political organisation.
- 4) For the purposes of this Law, and where not specified otherwise, the terms “agent of (a) foreign powers”, “agent in the employ of (a) foreign power(s)”, or “agent in the employ of the interests of (a) foreign power(s)” shall mean any individual who agrees to act as an employee, public relations officer, attorney, legal counsel or representative of a foreign power or a business or organisation subsidised in whole or in part by a foreign power, except where such individual is serving in the employ of an accredited diplomatic delegation to the Amissopian Federation or an international organisation of which the Amissopian Federation is a member.

ARTICLE II

- 1) Within thirty days of the passage of this Law, all agents of foreign powers active within the Amissopian Federation must register themselves as such with the Minister or an officer to whom the Minister delegates responsibility for registering foreign agents for the purpose of this Law.
- 2) Agents of foreign powers who become such after thirty days have elapsed for the purpose of II.1 of this Law must register themselves with the Minister or an officer to whom the Minister delegates responsibility for registering foreign agents for the purpose of this Law within thirty days of themselves beginning employment with the foreign power whose interests they serve.
- 3) Documents of registration effectuating the above provision must contain the following information:
 - a. The name, business address and residence address of the individual registering;
 - b. The name of the foreign power or other organisation for whom the individual is working and thus required to register under the provisions of this Law;
 - c. A copy of any contracts of employment for the purposes of their responsibility to the foreign power to which the individual has affixed their signature in pursuance of employment with said foreign power;
 - d. The date when any such contracts were made;
 - e. Details of the compensation which the individual receives for their service to the foreign power;



- f. An affirmation that the details enumerated in the registration are true and complete to the best of the registering agent's knowledge.
- 4) The Federal Criminal Code of the Amissopian Federation is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. Section IV: "Crimes Against the State" shall be amended to have a new Section 13, pushing all subsequent sections forward, which shall read as follows:
 - i. "It shall be a criminal offence for any individual to fail, within the temporal parameters specified by the Foreign Agent Registration Law in II.1 and II.2 of said Law, who is required to register themselves as an agent of a foreign power under the terms and definitions of said Law, to register themselves as an agent of a foreign power with the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State Department. This offence may be referred to in short hand as "failure to register as an agent of a foreign power when required to do so"."
- 5) The Minister may, where convinced that an agent of a foreign power is reasonably unable to procure documentation required to register legally under the provisions of II.3 of this Law, exempt at their discretion certain agents from being required to register certain elements enumerated in II.3.a-e of this Law where necessary.

ARTICLE III

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Foreign Agent Registration Law.
