



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of creating a series of tools for the government to use as sanction against foreign powers

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

- 1) For the purpose of this Law, “foreign powers” refers to the government of a foreign nation or a supranational organisation of multiple foreign governments.
- 2) For the purpose of this Law, “the Amissopian Federation” refers to:
 - a. The territories of the Amissopian Federation as enumerated by law;
 - b. Any territories under military or civil occupation by the Amissopian Federation.
- 3) For the purpose of this Law, “tariffs” refers to the practice of setting additional taxes on any products sold within the Amissopian Federation by a certain foreign power for the purpose of stifling said foreign power’s economic growth.
- 4) For the purpose of this Law, “assets” are any physical object or other item of value belonging to another individual or, especially, a foreign power.
- 5) For the purpose of this Law, the practice of freezing assets refers to the practice of preventing anyone from accessing them. This practice is distinct from asset seizure insofar as it does not include rendering the assets into the government’s property.

ARTICLE II: SANCTION POWERS

- 1) The President, or an officer to whom the President delegates this authority at their discretion, may, by Presidential Directive (or Executive Order, if issued by a delegated officer):
 - a. Freeze any assets held by a foreign power within the Amissopian Federation;
 - b. Set tariffs on products from nations governed by a foreign power;
 - c. Seize any assets held by a foreign power within the Amissopian Federation.

ARTICLE III: EXTENT, COMMENCEMENT AND SHORT TITLE

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Foreign Power Sanction Law.
