



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of asserting Amissopian support for the claim of the Federated States of Transterra to the State of New York over competing claims made by the Republic of Verus

ARTICLE I

- 1) The Amissopian Federation:
 - a. *Asserting* that the Federated States of Transterra was the first currently active micronation to stake a micronational claim to the area within the State of New York;
 - b. *Noting* that the Republic of Verus has made a claim to possession of territory within the State of New York;
 - c. *Maintaining* that no two nations may lay claim to the same geographical territory;
 - d. *Reiterating* that Transterra was the first micronation to lay claim to the State of New York, in whole or in part;
 - e. *Hereby resolves* as follows:

ARTICLE II

- 1) The Amissopian Federation hereby refuses to recognise the land claims of the Republic of Verus and, furthermore, the legitimacy of the constitutional Verusian government, until such a time as one of the following is true:
 - a. The claims of the Republic of Verus to the area within the State of New York is clarified to the satisfaction of the Amissopian Federation and the government of the Federated States of Transterra;
 - b. The claims of the Republic of Verus within the State of New York are withdrawn.
- 2) The provisions of II.1 of this law notwithstanding, the Government of the Amissopian Federation shall not be bound under any circumstances into recognising the legitimacy of the Verusian government or the legality of their territorial claims.

ARTICLE III

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the New York Claims Law.
