



OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT - FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

A LAW

For the purpose of acknowledging Interim President Juan Guaido as the legitimate president of Venezuela

ARTICLE I

- 1) The Amissopian Federation:
 - a. *Concurring* with the judgement of the United States and other nations that the election of Nicolas Maduro as President of Venezuela was not legitimate;
 - b. *Recognising* that Article 233 of the Venezuelan Constitution prescribes that, if the President of Venezuela is “unavailable” to take power, the President of the National Assembly shall take office temporarily as President of the Republic;
 - c. *Recognising* Juan Guaido as President of the National Assembly;
 - d. *Recognising* that Nicolas Maduro is “unavailable” to take power on the basis of his illegitimate re-election;
 - e. *Hereby resolves* to enact this law, to wit:-

ARTICLE II

- 1) The Amissopian Federation hereby recognises Juan Guaido as the legitimate interim President of Venezuela.

ARTICLE III

1. This law shall take effect upon presidential signature.
2. This law shall affect the entire Federation.
3. This law may be referred to in short hand as the Venezuelan President Law.
